Message for Teachers

When we see ourselves as **instruments**, we understand that **knowledge is not ours — it flows through us.**

We are simply channels through which divine wisdom passes to reach the students who need it.

The **world is already perfect** — there is nothing outside to change.

1. “Yasmānno udvijate loko...”

“One who does not disturb the world and is not disturbed by the world — who is free from excitement, fear, and anger — will attain divine peace within.”

A truly strong person is not one who controls others, but one who remains calm and steady even when others are restless.

When your peace is *not shaken by praise or blame*, you begin to reflect the Divine.

Let your presence bring calmness to others — not tension.

 *When your mind is peaceful, the world becomes peaceful through you.*

2. “Āpūryamāṇam acalapraṭiṣṭham...”


“Just as the ocean remains undisturbed even when rivers enter it, so also the person who remains unmoved with desires attains peace.”

The mind should be like the **ocean** — full, deep, and steady.

Many thoughts and desires may flow into it, but it must stay calm within.

If we run behind every desire, we lose peace.

When we remain full from within — content and steady — nothing can shake us.

 *Peace comes not by fulfilling all desires, but by remaining unmoved amidst them.*

“The perception has to change” — captures the essence of transformation itself. When the **way we see** changes, the **world we see** changes.

Here’s how you can express that idea powerfully and simply — suitable for adding near the end of your workshop or teachers’ message:

Change Your Perception — Change Your World

The world outside is not the problem;

it is our **perception** that makes it seem so.

When we look with irritation, we find faults.

When we look with patience, we find understanding.

When we look with love, we see divinity everywhere.

Nothing needs to change outside — only the **way we see**.

A peaceful person lives in a peaceful world.

An angry mind sees only conflict.

A compassionate heart sees only beauty.

When perception changes, life transforms.

 The saints say — *we don’t see things as they are; we see them as we are.*

So purify your mind, and the world will appear pure.
